In 2007, Dr. Chous also served as the MOA's chair of the State Fair Committee, promoting volunteerism among MOA's statewide optometrists and their staffs at the MOA booth at the Minnesota State Fair's HealthKare11 Building, for screening and education. Dr. Chous received a Bachelor's degree in Visual Science from the Southern California College of Optometry and was the Valedictorian of her class at Southern California College of Optometry. She and her husband Rob, also an optometrist, live in Shoreview with their three children.
